Rehearsals will be held every Wednesday evening. The first rehearsal will be held on **Wednesday, September 20, 2017 from 6.30pm – 9pm., in the Fine Arts Building, University of Alberta, room 123.**

Rehearsals require that you arrive at 6.15pm, and be seated by 6.25pm, in time to warm up and go through the tuning procedure. All cell phones must be turned off during rehearsal.

Membership in an orchestra is a commitment to be taken seriously.

An orchestra does not function unless everyone is there. To be a member of an orchestra implies that you are there at every rehearsal and concert.

Study the enclosed schedule carefully, and observe all the dates listed. Attendance at all rehearsals and concerts is mandatory, except in the case of illness or other unavoidable absences cleared with the EYO office by email: eyo@shaw.ca or telephone 780 436 7932 before the rehearsal.

Failure to comply with the above may result in termination of your EYO membership. With your cooperation and commitment we can work toward the excellence that has been the tradition of the Edmonton Youth Orchestra.

Concert tickets:

All orchestra members are given 4 tickets (a total of \$50) to sell for each concert, payment to be made at Wed. rehearsal, prior to concert. Extra tickets may be obtained at rehearsals, from the EYO office, or Tix on the Square 420 1757 \$15 for adults, \$10 for seniors & students.

Concert dress is required for all performances: Boys: Black or navy trousers & jacket; black bow tie; white shirt; black shoes & socks. Girls: Long black ankle length dress, or long black ankle length skirt with long sleeved black blouse, Sleeves elbow length or longer, high neck line; black shoes and tights. (No slits, or colours to be worn)

A concert is an occasion and only conservative dress is appropriate.

Included in the agenda are reports from the 2016-2017 season, plans for the 2017-2018 season, election of officers, & approval of financial statements.

Concerts on Sundays at 2pm in the Winspear Centre Concert Hall: November 26, March 4, May 6. Concert tickets sales are a major part of EYO fundraising, and give our members the opportunity to perform in a world class facility. **All EYO members are obliged to sell at least \$50 of tickets for each concert:** adults \$15, seniors and students \$10. EYO concerts are fantastic, plan to bring all your family and friends to every concert to enjoy a wonderful afternoon of music.

Music is very expensive. **EYO librarians: Senior Orchestra; Helen Privora, Intermediate Orchestra; Connie Lu,** organize the distribution and collection of all orchestral sheet music. Students must follow the **Guidelines for Care of Music** distributed at the beginning of the season, & hand in their music at the end of each concert, unless told otherwise.

Orchestra members must arrive 15 mins. prior to the beginning of the rehearsal, to set up chairs @ stands, & be in their seats 5 mins prior, in time to warm up and go through the tuning procedure. All cell phones to be turned off during rehearsal. Sat. S.O. arrive 8.45am. Wed. I.O. arrive 6.15pm. Everyone is to stack chairs and stands at rehearsal end.
