Meet Jordan Nahamko, our newest conducting intern.


Edmonton trumpet player and Loyal Edmonton Regiment military reserve band musician Jordan Nahamko is a recently graduated student from the University of Alberta music





### **Scholarships**

Scholarships are awarded each year to encourage the musical development of EYO musicians. These scholarships are awarded on the basis of performing ability, potential, and contribution to the EYO. To be eligible, candidates must meet each specific scholarship's requirements. Some scholarships require auditions; others do not. Our scholarship webpage provides

- Please confirm the eligibility requirements through the <u>EYO scholarship page</u>.
- Complete and submit the appropriate scholarship application form(s) with your audition. Forms available through the website and at rehearsals.
- Your scholarship audition is also your 2024-2025 instrument audition. You do not need to submit two separate auditions.
